

Project Update for the Week of March 2nd

The contractor will be connecting new pipe to the existing water system on the week of March 2nd. Customers affected are shown on the following maps on the indicated dates and can expect to be without water from 8:00 to 5:00 p.m. Crews will be in the area doing prep work prior to Tuesday. District staff has posted door hangers to notify affected residents.

We realize this is inconvenient for customers and will try to make the shutdown as short as possible.

When the water service returns, there may be some discoloration in the water due to some stirred up sediment. The sediment is inert, so it is not harmful, and your water is still safe to drink. Customers may need to flush the pipes in your house to clear out any of this discolored water. To flush, use a cold water, non-aerated source, such as a hose bib or bathtub.




# of Valves Turned	3
